## LACK OF CLARITY IN THE E-HEALTH SECTOR : SHOULD THE LIGHT BIRHTEN

To put into orbit an actually promising path in the scope of e-health is not only desiderable, it is essential for our country. Gathering the main providers of this high-tech special field, LESSIS intends to play a major part in its building up and to clear the ground in order to do so.

The building of such a path, dedicated to go into export, in the field of e-health is a real and bold challenge, but it seems within reach, given that the ecosystem should be ready to participate in. One condition to encourage such initiatives is that the rules governing this market in our own country should be clear and transparent.

About this point, the opacity which has for long dominated such and such fields of e-health represents one of the serious drawbacks to the booming of companies dedicated to this sector. Therefore, and since it seems vital to clean out those constraints, the LESISS Feederation launched during last spring an operation aimed at establishing the relevant transparency.

In accordance with the <u>roadmap</u> which was presented last spring, the planned actions have started. The objective is to highlight atypical practices of some actors in the French market. The materials so gathered, related among others to the hospitals, already provide a first and very interesting perspective.

Willing to share the belefit of this analysis with the actors of the e-health and wellfare market, the LESISS Federation has just delivered on its web site <u>some of the first results</u>, which will be updated as they come.

In addition to our letters of request for information and the corresponding answers of CADA (French Commission for Access to Administrative Documents), an interesting analysis – to be updated as it comes – is provided as well.

Builiding up a e-health industry, export-oriented, is definitely a challenge that France cannot discard. Particular interests must give way to team gaming, by associating, with full transparency, all the existing resources. Let us build up this new road. Together.
